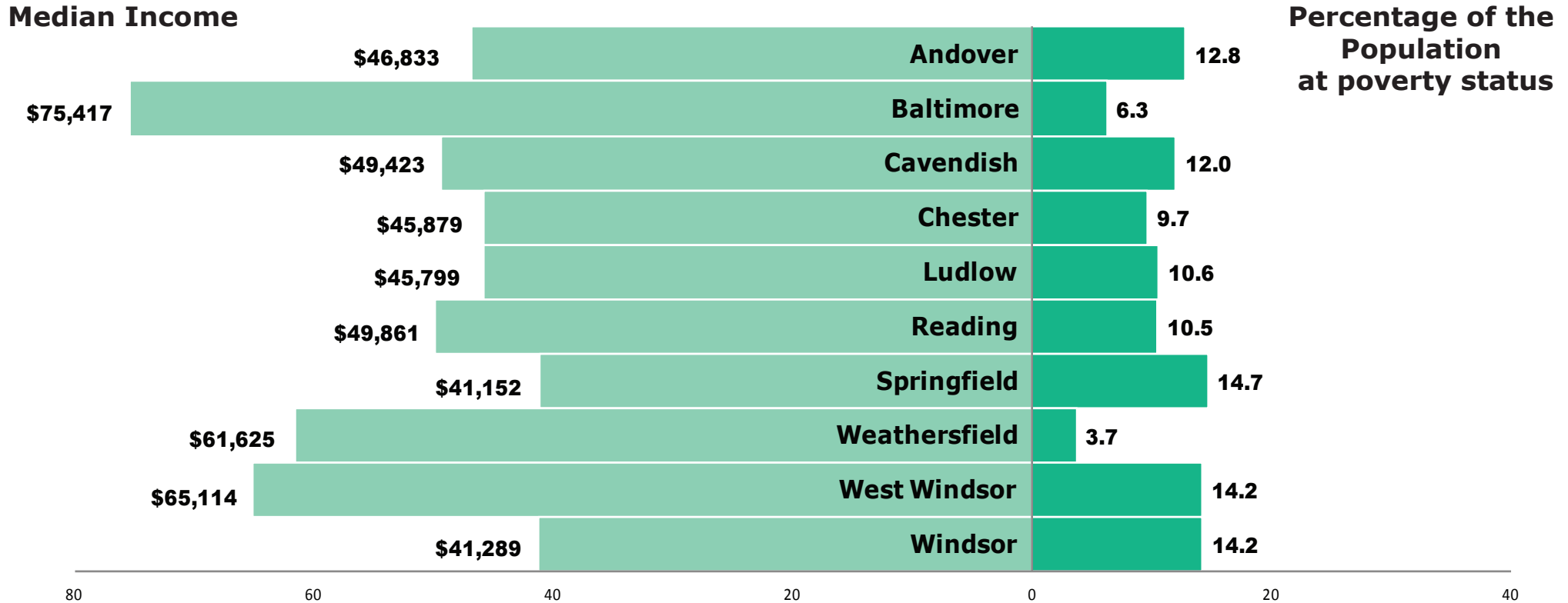


Poverty and Income in the Southern Windsor Region



Median household income levels vary greatly across the region – while most towns are in the \$40,000 - \$50,000 range, three towns have over \$60,000 in Baltimore, Weathersfield and West Windsor. This is quite comparable to \$55,000 for the US and \$56,000 for VT. The poverty data is reported as a percentage of all people. 15.1% of people in the US are in poverty compared to 11.6% of people in Vermont.

To truly compare income and poverty levels we also have to consider how much it costs to live. A good source of Vermont specific information is the “Basic Needs Budgets and the Liveable Wage” report which is prepared every two years for the Vermont Legislature.
