

Public Hearing Notice

The Vermont Transportation Board will hold a public hearing to consider an application to designate Route 100 from Pittsfield to Andover as a Vermont byway. The application, which includes a Corridor Management Plan, is the result of a joint effort of town representatives from Pittsfield, Killington, Bridgewater, Plymouth, Ludlow and Andover, Okemo Valley Regional Chamber of Commerce, Office of Killington Economic Development and Tourism, local businesses, and the Southern Windsor County and Two Rivers-Ottawaquechee Regional Planning Commissions.

The Corridor Management Plan provides a framework for the development, promotion and preservation of the abundant intrinsic resources along the corridor, to be named the Scenic Route 100 Byway. The 6 towns included in this application are Andover, Ludlow, Plymouth, Killington, Bridgewater and Pittsfield.

The public hearing will be held on April 13, 2011, 6:00-7:00PM at the Calvin Coolidge State Historic Site, Museum and Education Center, Route 100a, Plymouth.
